# Back to School Tips

- 1. Set your children's' sleep schedules back to "School Time" two weeks before the first day
- 2. Set -- and enforce -- regular weekday and weekend bedtimes
- 3. Encourage your kids to read at least one book before the school year begins
- 4. Refresh your rules about screen time for the school year. What's allowed and when? Check www.webwise.ie for ideas
- 5. Remove things like mobile devices from kids' bedrooms to focus them on sleeping
- 6. Remember to wear the full school uniform no branded jumpers or tracksuits are permitted
- 7. Remember that school starts at 8:45am and finishes at 1:25pm for the Junior & Senior Infants and 2.25pm for all other classes
- 8. Park N' Stride parking permits will be issued to all parents in the first week. If you need two, just ask (3)
- 9. LIDL is our closest Park N' Stride and James St. Car Park is only 4 minutes' walk
- 10. School bags on wheels are a great idea. If you think your child's school bag is too heavy, check that they need to bring home all of their books and consult with the class teacher
- 11. Healthy Lunches every day, with a small treat on a Friday
- 12. Have your kids pack their school bags before they go to sleep that night
- 13. Encourage your child to help making their own lunch. They are more likely to enjoy it if they had a hand in making it
- 14. We can all get the "Back to school nerves!" It's a normal part of growing up. Talk about it and remember that you will be ok!
