

Back to School Tips

1. Set your children's' sleep schedules back to "School Time" two weeks before the first day
2. Set -- and enforce -- regular weekday and weekend bedtimes
3. Encourage your kids to read at least one book before the school year begins
4. Refresh your rules about screen time for the school year. What's allowed and when? Check www.webwise.ie for ideas
5. Remove things like mobile devices from kids' bedrooms to focus them on sleeping
6. Remember to wear the full school uniform – no branded jumpers or tracksuits are permitted
7. Remember that school starts at 8:45am and finishes at 1:25pm for the Junior & Senior Infants and 2.25pm for all other classes
8. Park N' Stride parking permits will be issued to all parents in the first week. If you need two, just ask 😊
9. LIDL is our closest Park N' Stride and James St. Car Park is only 4 minutes' walk
10. School bags on wheels are a great idea. If you think your child's school bag is too heavy, check that they need to bring home all of their books and consult with the class teacher
11. Healthy Lunches every day, with a small treat on a Friday
12. Have your kids pack their school bags before they go to sleep that night
13. Encourage your child to help making their own lunch. They are more likely to enjoy it if they had a hand in making it
14. We can all get the "Back to school nerves!" It's a normal part of growing up. Talk about it and remember that you will be ok!
